INITIAL NARRATIVE (AMH)

Reporting Officer: DISSER, JIM

At the above date and time Officer Disser was dispatched to the Mobil Mart on Busha Hwy. in reference to a disorderly customer. Upon arrival officer observed a Port Huron taxi cab parked out front. Officer observed a white female, who was later identified as Lisa Sinclair, standing in the corner of the building. Officer approached her and asked her if officer could be of assistance. She stated she called a cab when she was at the Lynwood Bar because she felt that she was too drunk to drive. She stated that she asked the driver to take her to St. Clair. While in the cab the driver allegedly asked her if she had money to pay. She became extremely indignant at that point, so much so that the cab driver dropped her off at the Mobil Mart and did not desire any payment, and he wished only to leave.

Sinclair was observed to be heavily intoxicated as evidenced by bloodshot eyes, loud obnoxious behavior and a strong odor of intoxicants emanating from her person. She became fixated on the driver of the cab and the fact that he had asked her for payment prior to arrival at her destination. She then became very profane calling the driver a "pussy" and a "faggot". She was advised to cease this type of profanity due to the fact that she was standing outside and there were other customers present at the Mobil Mart.

Officer Gerrow arrived on scene and listened to Sinclair for several more moments and then also advised her to cease her loud and obnoxious behavior. She then turned her anger towards officers proceeding to use loud and

profane language with officers repeatedly after being told to stop. At one point officer asked the gas station attendant to call the individual another cab, and officer advised Sinclair to go inside the gas station to wait and to control her behavior.

Officers were preparing to leave the scene when Sinclair came back outside, and in the presence of two Mobil Mart customers stated to officers "fuck you" and proceeded to laugh and use profanities in a loud voice. The suspect's actions clearly disturbed the peace and good order of the neighborhood, specifically that of the customers of the Mobil Mart. At this point Officer Disser advised Sinclair that she was under arrest, and Officer Gerrow advised her to turn around so that officers could place handcuffs on her. Minimal force was used to secure her in handcuffs. The handcuffs were spaced and double locked by Officer Gerrow and the suspect was placed with some difficulty into the rear of patrol unit #676.

Officer Disser transported Sinclair to the St. Clair County Jail where she was booked and lodged on one count of Disorderly Conduct (to-wit: Disturbing the Peace).

While at the jail Sinclair continued her loud and obnoxious behavior. She was defiant with the corrections officers and refused to submit to a preliminary breath test. She was placed in a holding cell pending release when sober.

WITNESS STATEMENT

Jonathon Donbrosky advised officer that he was working behind the counter at the Mobil Gas Station when the above defendant and a cab driver arrived in the parking lot. The female exited the cab and began yelling and screaming at the cab driver, who also had exited his vehicle. During the course of the conversation the witness in this matter did hear on numerous occasions swear words and name calling from the suspect listed above, Lisa Sinclair, to the cab driver. At one point the cab driver did make entry into the party store requesting very calmly to have the Marysville Police respond to assist with the situation.

NARRATIVE

Upon arrival officers located the suspect, Lisa Sinclair, at the side of the Mobil Mart. During this point Officer Disser was conversing with the defendant who was upset over the cab driver's request to pay her fare prior to being dropped off at a residence. The defendant became argumentative with the cab driver and began verbally arguing with him in the cab. At that point the cab pulled over in the front of the Mobil Gas Station. At that point the witness observed both parties to argue back and forth and heard the female use several obscene words directed at the cab driver. At one point the cab driver made entry into the store asking to have the police called to assist him with the defendant as she was very disorderly.

Upon arriving Officer Disser made contact with Sinclair first. Upon Officer Gerrow's arrival officer heard Sinclair on numerous occasions as she told the story to Officer Disser use the profane language indicating and directing the word "pussy" towards the cab driver. After hearing this numerous times along with the word "fuck" officer advised her that she would need to refrain from using profanity in public and asked her to stop or she would be arrested for Disorderly Conduct. At that point she did stop using the profane language, and the cab driver indicated

that he did not need money for the fare. He advised that he would just not continue her journey from the Lynwood Bar to her residence and left the area.

After leaving Sinclair walked up to Officer Gerrow and indicated "Why was there a need for three police officers?" indicating Officer Gerrow, Officer Disser and United States Border Patrol Agent Mike Locke. At that point officer advised her that officers are always dispatched by twos, and that the Border Patrol Agent just assisted by coming to check on officers. Sinclair then began talking very loudly directed at Officer Gerrow indicating "Your just like that cab driver. Your the same as the cab driver". Officer again advised Sinclair to watch her language and not use any swear words. She then indicated that she was talking to a pole and not officer. Officer advised her that was fine, but she was not to use profane language. Officer Gerrow proceeded to get in his patrol unit to leave and Officer Disser did the same. In doing so Officer Disser had his passenger side window down and heard Sinclair yell very loudly in his direction and Officer Gerrow's direction a profane statement. At that point officers approached Sinclair and made an arrest for Disorderly Conduct. During the entire incident the above witness was present and observed officer's actions along with the defendant's actions.
